Registrar: Regarding the prerequisites – did Amy Jones supply a list of specific courses? Can we make sure that list is attached to the proposal? Jennifer Wade-Berg also said to STATE – we also need the crosswalk.</p> <p>Motion to approve made by D.M. Franklin & Seconded by Kim Loomis Discussion Ensued: Bill Griffiths – I have a concern that students could get through here without <i>any</i> formal Math classes and that doesn't seem right.
