2. Students will be able to recognize, identify, and evaluate various interpretations of philosophical traditions and methods of philosophy.
3. Students will be able to conduct philosophical research using appropriate sources and research ethics.
4. Students will be able to use interpretations of philosophical texts to critically examine philosophical problems/questions.
5. Students will be able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, using proper grammar and writing conventions of the discipline, including citation format.
